

TIM TRAMNITZ FLIES IN THE FIRST COLLECTIVE TEST AT RED BULL RING

Tim Tramnitz (Trident Motorsport) was quickest in the first collective test at **Red Bull Ring** for the **Formula Regional European Championship by Alpine**. The rain didn't bother the German driver, who climbed the top of the times from the beginning of the session until the checkered flag.

A lap of 1m 29.470s saw him go 0.521s faster than Estonian **Paul Aron (Prema Racing)**, who topped yesterday afternoon's session.

Francesco Braschi finished third, showing an excellent feeling with the **FA Racing** single-seater between the corners of the Austrian track. The Italian driver was ahead the championship leader **Dino Beganovic** (Prema Racing) and **Roman Bilinski (Trident Motorsport)**, both in the top five.

Victor Bernier (FA Racing) secured the sixth quickest time ahead of **Owen Tangavelou (RPM)** and **Dilano Van't Hoff (MP Motorsport)**, while **R-ace GP** duo **Hadrien David** and **Gabriel Bortoletto** completed the top 10.

The second collective test is scheduled this afternoon at 4.19 pm.
